ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING PROGRAM AT THE EAGLE GOLD MINE

VICTORIA GOLD HAS A ROBUST ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING PROGRAM at the company's Eagle Gold Mine to help ensure practices meet or exceed the mine's socio-economic and environmental assessment permitting terms and water license and Quartz Mining License (QML) requirements.

The program also provides documentation of the conditions both on-site and in the vicinity of site; from Potato Hills to the South McQuesten River.

Environmental monitoring covers a variety of areas including, but not limited to:

- > Surface Water
- > Groundwater
- > Air Quality
- > Aquatic Environment
- > Wildlife

Sampling results are reported regularly to the Yukon Water Board and the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun (FNNND) Land Department and are publicly available at: www.yukonwaterboard.ca/WATERLINE/.

The *Comprehensive Cooperation and Benefits Agreement (CBA)*, signed between Victoria Gold and FNNND in October 2011, supports an environmental monitor position from the First Nation. This position is currently held by FNNND Citizen **Bryan Moses**, who has been in the role since the Fall of 2018.

The FNNND Environmental Monitor regularly participates by independently collecting samples to allow the First Nation access to its own independent environmental data base. The samples include a range of metrics including: total suspended soils; nutrients; and, metals. Depending on the sample area, sampling frequency varies from daily and weekly to monthly, quarterly, annually or ongoing.
